

P4H Term 2 Overview

We have a very busy and exciting term planned for the pupils in Primary 4H. Here is a summary of the planned learning:

Literacy/Languages	Writing: This term we will be looking at letter writing and writers craft. Spelling: We will be revisiting sounds and common words this term. Reading: Pupils will be reading in groups, with a focus on comprehension. There will be a mix of fiction and nonfiction texts. We will also be looking at biographies. Accelerated reader: Pupils will be encouraged to increase their comprehension skills through the Accelerated Reader Programme. There will be opportunities to read their home readers in class each day. Grammar: Vocabulary/Connectives/Openers/Punctuation/Handwriting French: We will be focusing on basic vocabulary, greetings, colours and numbers.
Numeracy	We will have a focus on money and time. There will be a constant emphasis on number and mental maths. We will also be looking at open ended problem solving activities.
Health and Wellbeing	PE: This term we will be working on skills in basketball and football. Every Monday P4H will have a PE lesson with the visiting PE specialist. Health: There will be a focus on reflective practice, mindfulness and resilience.
Expressive Arts	This term we will be looking at graphic design and using art in marketing, through our Hazlehead Inc IDL topic.
Technologies	This term we will be looking at internet safety and the correct use of technologies in school.
Science	Our science block this term will be linked closely to our technologies block, looking at famous scientists and inventors.
RME	We will be recapping Christianity this term as we move towards Christmas.
Music	Every Tuesday the class will take part in a music lesson with Mrs Fisher.

This term, the Primary 4 Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL) topic is: Hazlehead Inc

- PE kits should be brought in on Monday and taken home on Friday to be washed.
- Homework will be given on a Thursday and returned for the following Tuesday.
- Spelling words are developed on Monday and practised throughout the week. The pupils will receive their spelling words on a Monday via Google Classroom, before the spelling test on Friday. Children are encouraged to practice at home, but are not required to submit anything.
- Assembly will take place on Wednesday and the Ethos block is on a Friday.
- Please help your child develop their personal organisation by encouraging them to use their homework diary every day.
- Children are encouraged to bring water bottles into class, to ensure that they are suitably hydrated.
- Children are encouraged to bring a personal reading book into class. Books can also be signed out from the School Library. We will visit the library on a Monday morning.
