Literacy	Reading <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Continue to work towards our AR targets. Please encourage the children to read at home.- Guided reading in class. A wide variety of activities that involve reading alone, with a group or partner or with the teacher. They will also be asked to complete different tasks that develop their decoding skills and their comprehension or they may involve aspects of grammar or spelling.- there may be times when reading or a reading activity is sent home. Writing - Our main focus will be imaginative writing. We will be learning how to write intriguing and interesting settings and creating fascinating characters. We will be using simile, metaphor, personification, alliteration and other tools to develop our writing.
