

Global Group December 2018

In Global working group we have been working very hard on a brand new initiative that we will be introducing and implementing from Primary 1 to Primary 7.

The children are cooperatively designing '95 Things to do before you leave Hazlehead Primary School'. This is a grid with life skills and fun activities for children of all ages to achieve. These achievements are directly linked to our 5 school values – Responsibility Rhino, Respectful Rabbit, Opportunity Octopus, Fairness Frog and Courage Cat.

Once a child has completed a target, they will receive recognition for that value.

The Global working group has differentiated these targets into levels of difficulty – Gold, Silver and Bronze. It is roughly expected that pupils in P1-3 would work towards the bronze targets, P4-5 the silver targets and P6-7 the gold targets.

An example of what this looks like for Opportunity Octopus:

- Bronze – 'Build a snowman'
- Silver – 'Learn a new drawing technique'
- Gold - 'Have a pen-pal from another country'

The Global working group have really enjoyed this journey so far, and look forward to sharing our learning with the rest of the Hazlehead Primary School. Watch this space!
