GOOGLE CLASSROOM

As a school, we will continue to be uploading information for classes on Google Classroom. Please can you and your child get back into the routine of checking it every day, including Gmail, for class specific information. Information about P.E days and homework will be coming soon. This will be incredibly helpful should we ever go back to home learning or you as a family have to self-isolate. If there are any issues accessing Google Classroom, please contact your child's class teacher for support.

GOOGLE CHROME BOOKS

If you borrowed a Google Chrome Book during lockdown, please return it to school by Friday 28th August. Please return it in a plastic bag clearly labelled with your child's name. It should be placed in a box in the main reception area marked Google Chrome Books. Thank you.

OUTDOOR PE

Every class will continue to receive 2 hours P.E every week as is the statutory requirement in Scotland. Information about when your child will have P.E will be posted on the Google Classroom Stream. In order to minimise changing throughout the day and to limit the amount of equipment pupils are taking to school, I would ask all pupils to wear their P.E kit to school on the days they have P.E **instead** of their school uniform. Our P.E kit comprises of shorts/jogging bottoms, white t-shirt and school jumper. Pupils can wear their school shoes to school and have their gym shoes in their school bag to change or alternatively, they can wear their gym shoes/trainers to school.

COATS

As children will go out to play in all weathers, please ensure your child has a waterproof coat to wear to school and that it is clearly labelled.
