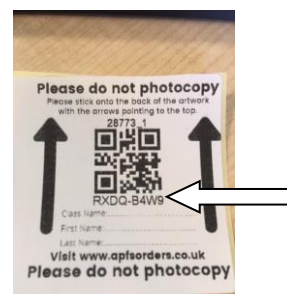
Step 1: Viewing your child's art work

- You can share this code with friends and family too



Step 3: Making a Purchase

- Visit www.apfsorders.co.uk
- Enter the unique artwork code as indicated in Step 2
- Enter your child's first name and surname
- Browse the range of cards and gifts available and make your purchase
