<u>Literacy</u>	Taught Writing: imaginative writing and fact files. Weekly grammar and spelling focus. Reading and comprehension Accelerated Reader targets
<u>Cross Curricular</u>	Cross curricular contexts: My World and My Literacy World. Our Big Questions for our My World context, chosen by the children, are: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. What makes me unique?2. How am I influenced by the wider world?3. What does my world look like in the future?4. What strategies help me grow?
<u>Other curricular areas</u>	Health & Wellbeing: weekly PE, AFCCT, games, social & emotional health including use of Emotion Works RME: Sikhism Art: cross-curricular and emotions based Homework - handed out on Thursdays and due in on Tuesdays
