

## P7 Term 4 Overview

We have a very busy and exciting term planned for the pupils in Primary 7. Here is a summary of the planned learning:

Literacy/Languages	<p><b>Writing:</b> Imaginative writing and Instructional writing</p> <p><b>Spelling:</b> Spelling lists are on Google Classroom for practice at home. A variety of strategies will be taught, alongside definitions and origins of words.</p> <p><b>Reading:</b> Pupils will be reading in groups, with a focus on comprehension. There will be a mix of fiction and nonfiction texts.</p> <p><b>Accelerated Reader:</b> Pupils will be encouraged to use the Accelerated Reader programme to increase their comprehension skills. There will be opportunities to read their home readers in class each day.</p> <p><b>Grammar:</b> Vocabulary/Connectives/Openers/Punctuation/Handwriting/Clauses</p> <p><b>German:</b> Pupils will have German with Mr Webster each Friday.</p>
Numeracy	<p>This term topical maths will cover money, time, measure.</p> <p>Our core maths will cover algebra and problem solving.</p> <p>There will be a constant emphasis on Big Maths (Beat Thats/CLIC and SAFE challenges).</p> <p>Problem solving strategies will be modelled and taught once a week.</p>
Health and Wellbeing	<p><b>PE:</b> Pupils will have PE each week, focusing on athletics and functional skills. This will lead us towards sports day. There is also a football leadership programme with AFC which takes place on a Tuesday afternoon.</p> <p><b>Health:</b> Healthy Relationships, RSHP and P7 Transitions. Coping strategies for moving into S1.</p>
Cross Curricular	<p>This term, the Primary 7 Cross Curricular topic is:</p> <p><b><i>Discovering our Wonderful World (Science)</i></b></p>
Technologies	<p>Technologies for research - Thinglink, WeVideo, Jamboard. These will be used within our cross-curricular context and when creating pupil profiles for S1.</p>
Expressive Arts	<p><b>Music:</b> Charanga Music and singing</p> <p><b>Art:</b> Mixed media</p> <p><b>Drama:</b> Mrs Hoy will incorporate drama into her lessons, using Scientific discoveries as the theme</p> <p><b>Dance:</b> We will be developing our performance skills as part of our P7 Leavers Show</p>
RME	<p>We will look at Christianity and Judaism throughout the year. Mrs Hoy will teach these religions discreetly on a Wednesday.</p>

- PE kits should be worn to school on Tuesday for PE sessions.
- Pupils should bring a change of footwear for the Messy Garden on a Thursday.
- Homework will be put up on Google classroom on a Thursday, to be completed by Tuesday. Pupils are required to personally take responsibility for checking and completing tasks.
- Spelling words are given out on Monday and practised throughout the week, before the spelling test on Friday. Children are encouraged to practice at home, but are not required to submit anything.
- Please help your child develop their personal organisation by encouraging them to use their homework diary every day.
- Children should be reading at home regularly in order to keep up with their AR target.
- Children are encouraged to bring water bottles into class, to ensure that they are suitably hydrated.
